[Pitt Finish Line Grant | Beginning Fall 2024](#)

Beginning in the fall of 2024, the [Pitt Finish Line Grant](#) will give one-time, nonrenewable grants to eligible students with financial holds or unpaid balances so those students can stay enrolled and complete their degrees. The program will support students across all five University campuses and will target those who may be lower income, first generation and Pell enrolled.
