Personal projects can be related to classroom topics, like developing websites, or they might combine interests, like helping a local animal shelter with updating their website.

There's also opportunities to build skills with other students in project based coursework or programs like iServe, which can be especially helpful at uncovering non-technical skills, such as teamwork, learning to delegate, and more.
